## 3. Agenda for our meeting – Matti Orrainen

MO presented the agenda. There were no recommendations for changes or additional issues.

- 4. Minutes from our Leipzig meeting
  - MO commented that the Information car forms and Fire Evacuation Drill guideline are ready for acceptance at CTIF general assembly in Bergen.
  - Member from Luxembourg wants to review the guideline proposal. Their feedback is expected before the end of June.
- 5. Reports from different activities/meetings, CFPA guideline commission Matti Orrainen
  - MO and SP present a short report of hot work meeting in Slovenia.
  - Presentation was followed with short discussion.
  - MO stressed the importance of CFCA guidelines and explained that they can be translated and used locally. They can be found in CFPA web pages (<u>http://www.cfpa-e.org/</u>).
- 6. Statistic from building fires and fire deaths, all
  - MO and HA presented the information on the number of fire deaths in Finland and Sweden.
  - Hans pointed a large number of fires in schools, while Matti reported on the Finnish desire to become the fire safest country among EU members.
  - Presentations were followed with discussion of GW, AJ, MO, SP, IL and IN.
  - MO presented SAFERA. It is home fire safety equipment that ensures that cooker use is safe without effecting normal cooking routines. Product details can be found here: <u>http://www.safera.fi/</u>
- 7. Examples of information cards, approval to publish them in web-sites Ilpo Leino
  - IL presented three versions of building fire information cards.
  - Presentation was followed with discussion.
  - IN pointed that Hungary has already established building fire information car. He will prepare short translation of Hungarian document.

- 8. Proposal for Handbook, approval?: Evacuation drill Ales Jug
  - AJ presented the final version of Fire Evacuation Drill Guideline.
  - GW expressed the wish that he would like to review the guideline. He pointed out that all the guidelines have to have the same form and key terms.
  - AJ will add key terms in the document until the end of May.
  - MO pointed out that this guideline is CTIF guideline and not CFPA guideline.
  - Date for the document review has been extended to June 30.
- 9. Other ideas for new proposals all
  - GW introduced two new Luxemburg guidelines that will be published in a recent future. First is Pre-incident planning, and the second is Performance based fire protection. Commission members agreed that the Pre-incident planning guideline is an important document for fire brigades. GW will prepare a short translation of new proposal.
  - Pre incident planning guideline is proposed to be a new guideline prepared by CTIF fire prevention commission.
- 10. Any other business all
  - RB introduced the one-year experience with 2010 Bulgarian fire safety act.
- 11. Next meetings
  - Next meeting will be in 24<sup>th</sup> week of year 2012 from 14<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2012 in Stockholm.

  - AJ will add key terms in the document until the end of May.
  - Date for the guideline review has been extended to June 30.
  - GW will prepare a short translation of new proposal: Pre-incident planning guideline. It'll be sent to MO.
