

Activities



The **Pop-Alert** project in which CTIF is a consortium partner held a demonstration workshop in **Lisbon** followed by a week of further project actions in **Corsica** at the beginning of February. Over 100 participants were involved in this work which aims to increase awareness and response by the public to crisis events. The Lisbon event was an earthquake and in Corsica a wildfire. Both will be fully reported upon in March at the final conference to be held in Brussels. See video:

In November CTIF experts were involved again in the **IAEA** First Responder Response Program and participated in **Nigeria** on National Training course for their First Responders. The Manual for First Responders response to radiological incidents that was prepared in cooperation with CTIF is still the most downloaded manual from IAEA. There were 32 participants from different agencies from all around Nigeria. We will continue cooperation with IAEA also in the future.



Extrication and New Technology held their meeting in **Rome, Italy** the 9th – 10th of December last year. It was combined with an ISO conference and a symposium held at the ISA Firefighter School in Rome.
